



# Camden Green Fair & Bikefest

## Sustainability Policy

The Camden Green Fair Steering Group (CGFSG) holds an annual green fair within the London Borough of Camden. The fair is an example of Education for Sustainability, which promotes environmental, political and social awareness and understanding; and encourages active participation from, and facilitates behavioural and lifestyle changes for, residents, business, public services, charities, community organisations and visitors in Camden.

We aim to ensure that the Fair itself, and the organisations, products and activities it promotes, have the smallest possible environmental impact.

The Camden Green Fair has a strict policy to:

- Ensure that power is provided by renewable energy, such as wind or solar, and that petrol and diesel generators and mains electricity is not used on site. Gas power is acceptable for food stalls only. Biodiesel and other generators powered by renewable sources will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
- Ensure that packaging is kept to a minimum, and as much as possible is recycled.
- Reduce our ecological footprint relative to the size of the fair
- Encourage use of sustainable forms of transport
- Ensure that stallholders and other organisations participating in the Green Fair comply with our sustainability policy

It is the responsibility of the Camden Green Fair Steering Group to ensure that this policy is implemented.
